



## **THE PROPOSED UGANDA COMMUNICATIONS COMMISSION GUIDELINES ON NATIONAL ROAMING**

The National Broadband Policy of September 2018 has, as one of its policy objectives, to increase broadband rollout and quality of service improvement through Telecom licensing reform. National Roaming was identified as one of the strategies for the realization of this.

In fulfilment of this and its mandate under section 5 of the Uganda Communications Act of 2013, Uganda Communications Commission (UCC) proposes the attached “the Uganda Communications Commission Guidelines on National Roaming”.
