



Terms and conditions for Licensing Distributors/Exhibitors

The Distributor of the Films and Video works and Exhibitors of films that granted a licence by the Uganda Communications Commission (UCC) shall:

1. Distribute only films that have been classified/censored and registered by the Media Council;
2. Display a copy of license at the main entrance of the premises;
3. Have that licence only valid for one year and which shall be renewed annually upon payment of fees prescribed by the UCC;
4. Not transfer the licence granted by the Commission;
5. Legibly display classification assigned by the Media Council in respect of any classified film on any material in the nature of advertisement in respect of the film;
6. Maintain a register containing among other things, the title and registered length of the film; the classification and other details of classification/censorship approval for the film; information regarding whether the film is a Ugandan film or a foreign film and such other particulars with respect to the film as may be required at any time by the UCC at the premises at which the films are delivered for distribution and shall make the same available to UCC on demand;
7. Have adequate ventilation and emergency exit commensurate with the seating capacity, appropriate sanitation facilities in and around the film viewing hall and no unnecessary slack electric cable;
8. On monthly basis forward to UCC the list of additional films/video works acquired for commercial use;
9. Insert a screen text on copies of rental films indicating that such films are rental copies;
10. Observe the restrictions imposed by classification in respect of films to be distributed;
11. Observe all other laws of Uganda and such other conditions as may be imposed by UCC from time to time.

We undertake to observe the foregoing rules and abide by the provisions of the Uganda Communications Act; number 1, of 2013 and Regulations made thereunder.
