## CESSATION OF PROVISION OF COMMUNICATION SERVICES

The Uganda Communications Commission (the Commission) was established under section 4 of the Uganda Communications Act, Cap 103 (the Act) as the regulator in the development of a modern communications sector that includes telecommunications, broadcasting, radio communications, postal/courier communications, data communication and communications infrastructure deployment.

According to Sections 42 of the Act, the Commission can suspend or revoke a license on grounds of serious and repeated breach of license conditions.

In accordance with its mandate under Sections 6 and 42 of the Act, the Commission hereby informs the public that the underlisted companies are no longer licensed to provide the services listed below.
