PRACTICAL INFORMATION

1. HOST COUNTRY

The Capital City of Uganda is Kampala. Often referred to as the 'Pearl of Africa,' Uganda is situated in Eastern Africa, a landlocked country, sharing borders with Kenya to the East, South Sudan to the North, the Democratic Republic of the Congo to the West, Rwanda to the Southwest, and Tanzania to the South. Uganda is home to Lake Victoria, the world's second-largest freshwater lake, and the source of the River Nile, the longest river globally.

The country's notable geographical features include the snow-capped Rwenzori Mountains in the west and Mount Elgon in the east, which has the largest volcanic base in the world. Uganda is also renowned for hosting some of the world's remaining Mountain Gorillas, extensive wildlife reserves, a year-round tropical climate, rich cultural diversity of over 50 ethnic groups and a vibrant nightlife. English is the official language in Uganda. The current population is 45.9 million.



2. DATES AND VENUE

The PAPU Plenipotentiary Conference is set to be held from **16th to 28th March 2026** at the picturesque Lake Victoria Serena Golf Resort & Spa situated along the serene shores of Lake Victoria, 17 kilometers from the Kampala City Centre and 30km from Entebbe International Airport.

3. VISA INFORMATION

Nationals of East African Community (EAC) member states are exempt from visa requirements when entering Uganda. Nationals of all other countries are required to obtain a visa prior to travel.

a) Requirements

- Passport copy (bio-data page) with at least 6 months' validity.
- Letter of invitation with clear address (the host country will provide this through the coordinators)
- Recent Passport-size photograph taken in the last 6 months.
- Vaccination certificate (Yellow Fever) certificate should be 14 days before date of travel
- Visa fees \$50.

b) Application for Uganda Visa.

Once your visa is approved, download the approval letter (**travel authorization/ visa approval letter**) and you can either go to the Ugandan Embassy in your country to have it personalized or you can travel and have it personalized at the point of entry at the Entebbe International Airport. You are encouraged to submit your e-visa applications 30 days in advance to allow for any delays or eventualities.

4. ACCOMMODATION

5. TRANSPORTATION

Complimentary transportation will be provided from the officially recommended hotels to the venue. Additionally, airport transfers to and from the recommended hotels will also be arranged. In the event that a delegate misses the scheduled airport shuttles, an alternative option is available: i.e. they can conveniently order a taxi through the self-service machine located right before exiting the arrival lobby on the left-hand side.

6. HEALTH AND VACCINATIONS

All visitors are required to be vaccinated against yellow fever and must present a valid vaccination card upon arrival at the airport. Delegates are also advised to purchase travel insurance before commencing their journey.

7. SECURITY AND ACCESS

Uganda is a very peaceful country and security is guaranteed. Access to the conference facility will be exclusively granted to individuals wearing the conference badges. Participants need to note that only delegates, observers, media representatives, PAPU and Host Country secretariat staff, as well as technical and support personnel, will be allowed entry to the conference premises upon the presentation of their respective badges.

8. ACCESSIBILITY

The conference venue is accessible to individuals with disabilities. Any further requests for accessibility services can be submitted during the registration process. Please note



9. CURRENCY AND BANKING

Uganda is largely a cash-based economy, with the Uganda Shilling as the main currency. However, major cards such as Visa, MasterCard, American Express, as well as PayPal, are widely accepted. Mobile money transfers are also commonly used, particularly by nationals of the East African region.


At the airport, ATMs are conveniently located immediately to the right after exiting the immigration and baggage claim area. Commercial banks operate from Monday to Saturday, between 9am to 4pm.

10. WEATHER IN MARCH

Uganda boasts a tropical climate characterized by plentiful sunshine throughout the year. March marks the transition from the dry to the wet season. Delegates should expect warm conditions with occasional heavy rainfall, particularly in the afternoons and evenings. Rainfall is frequent in Kampala, with showers possible on many days. Delegates are therefore advised to carry light jackets or rain jackets.

11. ELECTRICITY

In Uganda, the power plugs and sockets are of type G. Uganda operates at 240V and the standard frequency is 50Hz.



12. MEDICAL SERVICES

Medical services will be available at the conference venue, along with an on-site ambulance for medical transport.
